## 1. 2010 WORLD HARVEST STRATEGY

*(Please see definitions at point 4 for clarity of terms used)*

1. **To invite Churches** and organisations to become a Hosting body and to host a Team of Short term Missionaries (as either in point 2 or 3 beneath) during the 2010 World Cup, AND to do outreach programs in their community during this time.
  - The plan is that Churches and organisations recruit volunteers from within their own congregations and community to work with a Team of Short term Missionaries that will be allocated to them in their own community.
  - The church / organisation have to accommodate and host this team, and work with this team in doing outreach and community programs throughout the duration of the World Cup.
  
2. **To invite Individuals** to sign up to the 2010 World harvest program, and become part of a Short term Missionary team that will travel to a Hosting Body (as per point 1), where the Short Term Missionary team will be hosted for the duration of the World Cup, and where they will work with the Hosting Body in doing outreach and community programs in that specific community.
  
3. **To invite existing teams** of Short Term Missionaries from organisations like YWAM, OM, AIS, AIA, CSV etc. to work with a local Hosting Body (as per point 1), where they as a Short Term Missionary team will be hosted for the duration of the World Cup, and where they will work with the Hosting Body in doing outreach and community programs in that specific community.
  
4. **To Supply Training & available resources** to the Hosting body to be efficient in doing outreaches with the team of short term missionaries allocated to them within their community.

## 2. Main Outcome of the 2010 World Harvest project for the Hosting bodies, Volunteers, and Short term Missionaries:

1. Igniting a passion in the local church for lost souls
2. Winning souls for the kingdom of God – Evangelism based on EE3 / Way of the Master
3. Discipleship of new converts
4. Upliftment of community through community projects
5. Knowledge transfer in the form of training and literature to all individuals taking part in this programme.
6. Using the opportunity presented by the World Cup for Spiritual growth, Networking and Congregational growth.

## 3. Value statement : 2010 World Harvest

1. We believe the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, in their original writing, to be fully inspired by God and accept them as the supreme and final authority for faith and life.
2. We believe that God created man in His own image; that man sinned and thereby incurred the penalty of sin, which is death physically and spiritually and that all human beings inherited a sinful nature.
3. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for the sins of humanity as a substitution sacrifice according to the Scriptures and that all who believe in Him and proclaim Him as their personal Saviour are justified on the grounds of His shed blood.
4. We believe that every person on earth should hear the good news of the gospel in order to have a chance to choose between life and death.
5. We endeavour to carry out the great commission as given in Matt 19:28-29 in every possible way.

## 4. Definitions:

1. **Host City Coordinator** = An individual / church / group who wants to be part of this project in coordinating churches involved in this project in your city / town / village.
2. **Hosting body** = This is a church or group of people who wants to be part of this project in hosting a team of short term missionaries, and facilitating outreach events / community projects during the time of the 2010 world cup in their own specific community. This includes cities, towns and villages outside the borders of South Africa.
3. **Volunteer** = Any person who volunteers to be part of any World Harvest / Tug program and connects directly into these programs through their local church and / or group. A Volunteer differs from a **Short Term** Missionary in that their voluntary role is limited to their local church and / or group and does not require registration into the World Harvest program.

4. **Short term Missionary** = A Short term missionary is any individual who sign up for the 2010 World Harvest program and will become part of a Short term Missionary team
5. **Short term Missionary Team** =
  - A team formed in the World Harvest program by different individuals that have signed up for the program and being grouped together into a Team.
  - An existing team of Short Term Missionaries from organisations like YWAM, OM, AIS, AIA, CSV.
6. **Volunteer to accommodate short term missionaries** = This is an individual / family who wants to accommodate a short term missionary in their home, and is part of the Hosting Body.

## 5. Responsibilities of host city coordinators

1. Prepare your heart for outreach. A prayer guide is available on the website. Submit prayer time onto the prayer barometer on the website, [www.2010worldharvest.co.za](http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za)
2. Coordinating the hosting body / bodies involved in this project in your community / town / city.
3. The Host City Coordinator will liaise with the 2010 World Harvest Execution Team to ensure that everything is in place and on target for events that will occur in the city / town during the 2010 World cup.

## 6. Responsibilities of and minimum requirements for a Hosting body.

1. Register on the 2010 World Harvest website as a Hosting body
2. Arranging regular prayer time and prayer meetings starting as early as possible prior to the 2010 World Cup. A prayer guide is available on the website, [www.2010worldharvest.co.za](http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za)
3. Looking after the needs of the Team of Short term Missionaries allocated to your care.
  - 3.1. Accommodate individuals of the visiting team, either as individuals in homes of families who can host them or collectively in a venue where men and woman can sleep separately.
  - 3.2. One single bed/mattress to be provided per person
  - 3.3. Proper bathroom facilities, i.e. access to a toilet and bath or shower. If group is hosted together, separate bathroom facilities needs to be available for men and women.
  - 3.4. Three meals a day
  - 3.5. At least 1 Leisure day in every cycle of 7 days
4. There might be individuals that only want to accommodate short term missionaries. These individuals will be referred to the nearest host church / group that are part of the project.
5. Training: Please contact the 2010 World Harvest Team for assistance or see the TUG website for details on venues and contact person for registration, [www.theultimategoal.co.za](http://www.theultimategoal.co.za)
6. As Hosting body you will have to design your own program to facilitate outreach events during the 2010 world cup in your community based on the 2010 World Harvest / The Ultimate Goal training and/or previous experience.

7. Hosting Bodies must give feedback regarding the salvations and testimonies that occurred during their outreach programs to the 2010 World Harvest execution team in order to consolidate number of people that were saved and prepare this information for follow up, i.e.
  - 7.1. Name & a contact detail, i.e. either telephone number or e-mail or postal address
8. Congregations must also submit their prayer time onto the prayer barometer on the website, i.e. link: [http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za/submit\\_prayer\\_time.html](http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za/submit_prayer_time.html)
9. During the time of the 2010 World Cup, it is advised that the Hosting body together with the Team of Short term missionaries set up a 24 hour prayer tower in order to pray and intercede for the duration of the outreach program in the respective host cities.
10. Hosting Bodies are free to obtain donations that will help finance their programmes within their communities.
11. Before and after the short term missionary's period of missionary work, International missionaries can be transported to and from (received and sent back) Oliver Tambo International Airport / Capt Town International Airport by their hosting body. If road transportation is provided, it must be in a roadworthy vehicle and the driver must be in possession of a valid South African driver's licence.

## 7. Responsibilities and minimum requirements of a short term missionary

1. Register on the 2010 World Harvest website as a short term missionary, i.e. [www.2010worldharvest.co.za](http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za)
2. Prepare your heart for outreach. A prayer guide is available on the website. Submit prayer time onto the prayer barometer on the website, i.e. link: [http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za/submit\\_prayer\\_time.html](http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za/submit_prayer_time.html)
3. We have 2 types of programs for missionaries, i.e.
  - a. 10 June – 26 June 2010 (2.5 weeks)
  - b. 10 June – 12 July 2010 (4.5 weeks)For cost see point 9 below
4. Local missionaries to provide own transport to and from host.
5. International short term missionaries will be transported from Oliver Tambo International Airport to your host by either the host or 2010 World Harvest team. When time of departure comes, you will be transported back to Oliver Tambo International Airport by either your host or the 2010 world Harvest Execution team.
  - a. Short term Missionary Teams from other organisations have to make their own transport arrangements to and from their respective bases.
6. You will be hosted by a family/facility in your applicable host city
7. Food, accommodation and transport will be provided by your host family, i.e.
  - a. 3 meals per day will be provided.
  - b. 1 single bed/mattress will be provided. Bedding to be provided by the short term missionary
  - c. Toilet and bathroom facilities will be provided

- d. Transport to and from outreach/social events will be provided
8. As the hosting family is offering up their private space to accommodate the short term missionary, it is advised that missionaries' conduct will be reasonable and considerate towards the family.
9. Be available for outreach / community events as required by your host
10. Spending money will be for your own account
11. Leisure time and social events will form part of the outreach period
12. You must have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and be over the age of 18.
13. References may be requested regarding your Christian walk and character.
14. Your conduct must always be an example of good Christian character, and you must abstain from all alcohol and / or any other intoxicating substances like drugs, cigarettes etc. for the period of the outreach.

### **8. Responsibilities of a volunteer to accommodate a short term missionary**

1. Register on the 2010 World Harvest website as a volunteer to accommodate someone, i.e. [www.2010worldharvest.co.za/host\\_someone.html](http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za/host_someone.html)
2. Prepare your heart for outreach. A prayer guide is available on the website. Submit prayer time onto the prayer barometer on the website, [www.2010worldharvest.co.za](http://www.2010worldharvest.co.za)
3. Provide food, accommodation and transport for your short term missionary, i.e.
  - a. Accommodate short term missionary individual(s), either as individuals in homes of families who can host them or collectively in a venue where men and woman can sleep separately.
  - b. One single bed/mattress to be provided per person
  - c. Proper bathroom facilities, i.e. access to a toilet and bath or shower.
  - d. If group is hosted together, separate bathroom facilities needs to be available for men and women.
  - e. Three meals a day
  - f. Provide transportation to and from place of accommodation to all outreach/social events in a roadworthy vehicle. The driver must be in possession of a valid South African driver's licence.

## 9. Costs

The following Cost Table is for missionaries / hosting body representative that enrol directly into the World Harvest Program, and is for ministry inside the borders of South Africa.

- *(Any short term missionary team from other organisations will have their own cost structure as per their specific organisation.)*

### **NOTES:**

1. The Cost for the Training and Week of Prayer (8-14 March / 3-9 June) will cover all the training expenses, food and accommodation. Transport is for your own account.
2. The Cost for the Short Term Missionaries regarding the 2 / 4 / 6 week involvement is to cover their expenses during the week of prayer regarding training, food and accommodation, and certain parts of their transport.
  - a. Furthermore it will be used to acquire resources for the program and if there are funds available to assist the hosting bodies in their outreach programs.
3. All financial dealings are overseen by a Board of Directors and an independent Oversight committee.

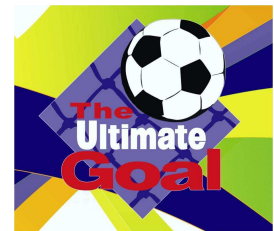
